# COVID-19 Guidance

## November, 2023

#### STAY HOME IF YOU TEST POSITIVE FOR COVID-19

### FIRST DAY OF SYMPTOMS, OR THE DAY YOU TOOK COVID-19 TEST (IF NO SYMPTOMS)

- 0 II Z 3 4 5 6 7 8 9 10 III
  - ♦ Stay home even if you are vaccinated.
  - Wear a high-quality mask if you must be around others at home and in public.
  - ♦ Monitor your symptoms, and call 911 if you need emergency medical care.
  - Active-Duty <u>MUST</u>, and non-active duty <u>SHOULD</u>, report positive home tests to their healthcare providers.

- If you usually get care in the TRICARE civilian healthcare network, contact your primary care provider or your TRICARE Regional Contractor.

#### DAY 6 YOU MAY LEAVE YOUR HOME

- ♦ You may leave your home on or after day 6 if you never had symptoms, or
- ♦ If symptoms have improved, and you have been fever-free for 24 hours without fever-reducing medicine
- You should continue wearing a mask through day 10.
- San Felipe students and staff should consult the school district guidelines for returning to school.

### **DAY 10** LAST DAY OF WEARING A MASK

- If symptoms are not improving, if you were hospitalized, or if have weakened immune system, consult your healthcare provider on ending isolation.
- You may resume normal activities <u>after day 10</u> unless you were advised otherwise by your healthcare provider.



#### WEAR A MASK IF YOU ARE EXPOSED TO COVID-19

#### DAY 0 EXPOSURE DATE

- Test immediately if you develop symptoms.
- Regardless of vaccination status, if you are exposed to COVID-19 you should wear a mask around others for 10 days.

#### DAY 6 TEST ON THIS DAY OR SOONER IF YOU HAD SYMPTOMS

- If you test negative continue wearing a mask through day 10.
- ♦ Isolate immediately if you test positive.

DAY 10 LAST DAY OF WEARING A MASK unless you develop symptoms.

## **ADDITIONAL GUIDELINES**

- Negative test results are not required to return to work.
- Personnel may wear a mask based on personal health concerns.
- Commanders may limit voluntary mask wearing if necessary for safety or military operational reasons.
- ♦ All members are <u>highly encouraged</u> to get vaccination boosters.
