GENERAL INFORMATION

DIALING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. DSN Calls from base extensions. Listen for dial tone, dial "94," wait for DSN dial tone and dial desired number.
- 2. Base Extension to Base Extension. Listen for dial tone. Dial desired number.
- 3. Del Rio Numbers. Listen for dial tone, dial "99," wait for city dial tone and dial "city prefix" plus last 4 digits of number.
- 4. Base Housing. Listen for dial tone, dial "99" wait for city dial tone and dial desired "298-" number.
- Long Distance from Base Extensions Contact your Telephone Control officer.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USING THE FEATURES ON SINGLE LINE TELEPHONE EXTENSIONS

- 1. Call Hold (Touch Call Only):
 - a. Ask party to wait.
 - b. Depress hook switch.
 - c. Hang Up.
 - d. To return to call on hold, depress hook switch.
- Transferring Calls: Incoming, outgoing or extension calls can be transferred.
 - a. Ask party to wait.
 - b. Depress hook switch.
 - c. Listen for feature dial tone.
 - d. Dial number.
 - e. Announce call.
 - f. Hang up.
 - g. **NOTE:** In case of busy signal, no answer or an error in dialing, depress hook switch to return to first party.
- 3. **Consultation Calling**: To hold one party and consult with another.
 - a. Depress hook switch.
 - b. Listen for feature dial tone.
 - c. Dial extension number.
 - d. CONSULT.
 - e. You are automatically reconnected when called extension hands up.

4. 3-Way Conference:

- a. Ask party to wait.
- b. Depress hook switch.
- c. Listen for feature dial tone.
- d. Dial extension number.
- e. Depress hook switch again to establish 3-way conference call.
- Ring Again: After dialing an extension number and receiving a busy signal.
 - a. Depress hook switch.
 - b. Listen for feature dial tone.
 - c. Dial "31."
 - d. Hang up.

- e. To cancel Dial "32."
- 6. **Call Pick-Up**: To answer an incoming call to any extension in your call pickup group: Dial "33."
- 7. Call Forwarding (Touch Call Only):
 - a. Key #, plus 1, plus extension number.
 - b. Hang up.
 - c. To cancel-Key #, plus 1.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USING THE FEATURES ON MERIDIAN MODULAR TELEPHONE EXTENSIONS

1. Placing a Call on Hold:

- a. Press the Hold Key. The indicator besides the line key will flash.
- b. To Return to a held call. Press the Line Key that is flashing.

2. Transferring Calls:

- a. Ask party to wait.
- b. Press Transfer Key. The calling party is on hold and you hear dial tone.
- c. Dial extension that you want to transfer the call to.
- d. Press Transfer again, either when you hear ringing or after you announce call.
- Conference Calls: You can set up a conference for up to 3 or up 6 parties, including yourself, if you have the correct feature code.

To set up a conference:

- a. Ask party to wait, press Conference. The other party is on hold and you hear the dial tone.
- b. Dial the number of the next party to add. When the call is answered, you may talk privately with the party.
- c. Press Conference again to include all 3 parties.
- d. Repeat a-c to add the 4th, 5th and 6th parties.
- 4. **Ring Again**: After dialing an extension number and receiving a busy signal.

To Use Ring Again:

- a. Press Ring Again when you get a busy signal.
- b. Hang up or press RLS.
- c. When you hear the Ring Again tone, select a free line.
- d. Press Ring Again to automatically dial the number.
- Call Forward: Call Forward allows you to send your calls to another extension. You cannot forward calls while the telephone is ringing.
 - a. To forward your calls:
 - 1. Press forward. The indicator flashes.
 - 2. Dial the extension that you want to forward your
 - 3. Press Forward again. The indicator flasher remains on.
 - b. To cancel forwarding:
 - 1. Press Forward. The indicator turns off.
 - c. To reinstate Call Forward to the same number:
 - 1. Press Forward twice. The indicator turns on again.

PROMOTING GOOD TELEPHONE SERVICE

Good telephone service is based on the accuracy, speed, and courtesy of both operating personnel and subscribers. Subscribers should be guided by the following rules:

- Security. Communications security is the protection designed to deny unauthorized persons valuable information derivable through their possession and study of telecommunications, or to mislead unauthorized persons in their interpretation of the results of such a study. Telephone users are responsible for the security of information discussed over the telephone, as prescribed in AFI 31-401.
- Brevity. For economy and maximum use of available facilities, telephone conversations should be as brief as possible. This is particularly true of long distance and DSN calls.
- Authorized Use. Personal matters or unofficial business should NOT be discussed over telephones that are authorized for official business only.

TELEPHONE TIPS

- 1. When you receive a telephone call:
 - a. Answer promptly.
 - b. Identify yourself when answering.
 - c. Speak distinctly and pleasantly. Hold mouthpiece well in front of lips.
 - d. Avoid trite and abrupt phrases.
 - e. Volunteer your assistance.
 - f. Request identity of caller only when necessary and in a tactful manner
 - g. Explain off-the-line delays.
 - h. Take messages willingly. Write essential details on a suitable message form. Deliver promptly.
- 2. When you make a telephone call:
 - a. Listen for dial tone. Dial carefully.
 - b. Place the call yourself. Make sure you are on the line ready to talk when the called person is reached.
 - c. Have the correct number in mind. Consult your
 - d. Identify yourself immediately to the first person answering the called telephone.
 - e. Try to complete your business on one call by securing information or leaving a message.
 - f. Volunteer your extension and the best time to reach you in case you request a call-back.
 g. Keep your conversation brief and businesslike.

TELEPHONE TROUBLE REPORTING

- All trouble encountered with administrative telephones and associated equipment will be reported by dialing "4199" for base extensions. From base housing and Del Rio dial (800) 483-1000.
- Administrative telephone troubles not corrected within a reasonable time should be reported to 47CS/SCOI, ext. 4282.
- When reporting trouble, the following information is required:
 - a. Telephone number (extension number).
 - b. Listing of telephone.
 - c. Location of telephone Building number and room number if known.
 - d Nature of trouble

REQUESTS FOR SERVICE

 Contact your unit's Telephone Control Officer to request installation of official telephone service or modification of existing official telephone service.

2. Unofficial Service Requests. Private service may be obtained by calling the VERIZON Telephone Company business office, (800) 483-4400. Contract arrangements for such private telephone service are made by the person involved, who is solely responsible for payment of any charges incurred. ONLY AUTHORIZED PERSONNEL MAY ADD. REMOVE. OR RELOCATE COMMUNICATIONS EQUIPMENT. (AFI 33-111)

LONG DISTANCE CALLS

- 1. Official long distance calls are paid by AETC appropriated communications funds. It is essential that these calls be held to the minimum. Every effort will be made to place calls over the DSN circuits or via toll-free numbers. Calls should be limited to 5 minutes or less and should be placed as station-to-station calls.
- 2. If placement of long distance calls via DSN cannot be accomplished, the Toll Free Information Operator will be contacted by dialing "0" and asking the base operator for "800" Information. If placement of a long distance call is necessary, the organizational telephone control officer will place the call using their assigned PIN #.
- 3. Incoming "collect" official calls will be accepted only after a billing number is obtained from the control officer of Command Post. The person accepting the call will call the control officer or Command Post on another line to obtain the billing number. The person accepting charges will then write the calling parties name, phone number and city they are calling from.
- 4. SOME PERSONAL CALLS MAY BE PLACED FROM BASE EXTENSIONS OR CLINIC EXTENSIONS. Public pay telephones are available for use in placing personal calls. Direct Distance Dialing (DDD) is available to the Base Housing Area (298 exchange) and the Del Rio exchanges by dialing "1," plus Area Code, plus number. All long distance calls from base and hospital extensions must be placed through the Telephone Control Officer.

NUISANCE AND THREATENING CALLS

Malicious, threatening, abusive, indecent, annoying, or harassing telephone calls, including those in which obscene or profane language is used, are prohibited by state and federal laws. The following actions should be taken if you receive such a call:

1. Nuisance Calls:

- a. Make the caller identify himself. When a voice asks, "Who is this?" ask instead, "What number did you dial?" or "Who do you want?"
- b. If the caller remains silent after you answer, or makes any obscene or suggestive remarks, HANG UP! If calls persist notify Security Police, exts. 5100/5555/5102. Furnish as much information as possible about the call and the caller.
- 2. Threatening Calls Received on Private Telephone:
 - a. Hang up.

b. Call Security Police, ext. 5100/5102. Base housing residents dial 298-5100 or 298-5102.

Bomb Threats or Other Threatening Calls Received on Government Telephone:

- a. DO NOT HANG UP.
- b. Try to keep caller on line.
- c. Signal someone else to call Security Police, ext. 5100.
- d. If no one is available, DO NOT HANG UP, but use another phone to notify Security Police.
- e. Obtain as much information as possible about the call/caller using the following checklist.
