SUBJECT: 47 FTW HPCON and COVID-19 Guidance Update

1. Laughlin AFB is in HPCON Normal (HPCON 0) effective immediately.
2. All personnel must continue to comply with current CDC guidance regarding exposures and isolation.
3. If you test positive for COVID-19, regardless of vaccination status, isolate at home for at least 5 days and wear a mask around others for 10 days. If you have no symptoms, you may end isolation after day 5. If you have symptoms, you may end isolation after day 5 if your symptoms are improving and you are fever-free for 24 hours. Healthcare personnel must follow current CDC infection control guidance for healthcare workers.
4. Regardless of vaccination status, if you are exposed to COVID-19 wear a mask around others for 10 days. If you develop symptoms, get tested. Healthcare personnel must follow current CDC infection control guidance for healthcare workers.
5. Unit Commanders are responsible for ensuring unit members adhere to this guidance.
6. We must continue to take everyday actions to stop the spread of germs: like washing your hands and covering your cough/sneeze. Vaccines are available at the 47th Medical Group and I encourage all of Team XL to make sure you, your family, and your teammates are protected from this virus. All members are highly encouraged to get boosters when eligible.
