COLONEL KEVIN A. DAVIDSON

Col. Kevin A. Davidson is the Commander of the 47th Flying Training Wing, Laughlin Air Force Base, Texas. The wing consists of 2,800 personnel conducting specialized undergraduate pilot training for more than 500 United States Air Force and allied student pilots each year. The wing operates 195 aircraft, consisting of the T-1A, T-6A and T-38C, and flies more than 66,000 hours and more than 44,000 sorties per year.

Col. Davidson earned his commission as a Distinguished Graduate through the Reserve Officer Training Corps program at the University of Arizona in 1998. Following Specialized Undergraduate Pilot Training at Columbus Air Force Base, Mississippi, he attended T-37 Pilot Instructor Training at Randolph AFB, Texas, and initial A-10 training at Davis-Monthan AFB, Arizona. As an A-10 pilot, he deployed and led combat sorties during Operation ENDURING FREEDOM. Following his A-10 assignments, Col. Davidson served as a Regional Affairs Strategist, Aide de Camp and Liaison Officer to the commander of the Republic of Korea Air Force Operations Command and 7th Air Force Commander, Osan AB, Korea. Following this assignment, Col. Davidson served as the Chief of Contingency Operations Branch and subsequently as Director of the Commander's Action



Group, Head Quarters Pacific Air Forces, Joint Base Pearl Harbor-Hickam, Hawaii. The colonel is a Distinguished Graduate of ROKAF's Joint Command and Staff Course, and U.S. Army War College. He is a command pilot with more than 2,800 flight hours, including more than 450 combat hours. Prior to his current position, the colonel was the Vice Commander, 378th Air Expeditionary Wing, Prince Sultan Air Base, Kingdom of Saudi Arabia.
