CMSgt Erik J. Garza is the Command Chief Master Sergeant, 47th Flying Training Wing, Laughlin Air Force Base, Texas. He is the key advisor to the wing commander on issues affecting Team XL's training, readiness, professional development, quality of life, and utilization of 2,800 military personnel and U.S. Civilians spanning 17 units. The wing operates 160 T-6A & T-38C aircraft, executing more than 44,000 sorties yearly in support of the premier Undergraduate Pilot Training mission, successfully graduating 360 USAF and allied nations' pilots each year.

Chief Garza is from Wapato, WA and enlisted into the Air Force in November 2000. He has vast cross-functional experience in the Squadron, Group, Wing, NAF, and combined joint headquarters to include advising and writing Enlisted Policy at the HAF level. Also, he has experience in the joint environment serving on the United States Forces Japan (USFJ) Joint Staff and is a graduate of the U.S. Army Command and General Staff College, Sergeants Major Course, Class 72, Fort Bliss, TX.
