CMSgt David C. Snarr is the Command Chief Master Sergeant for the 47th Flying Training Wing, Laughlin AFB, Texas. He serves as the principle advisor to the wing commander on all issues affecting the health, morale, welfare, professional development and readiness of nearly 2,800 military and civilian personnel. The wing operates 195 aircraft, consisting of the T-1A, T-6A and T-38C executing more than 44,000 aircraft sorties yearly in support of Laughlin's Specialized Undergraduate Pilot Training mission graduating 370 United States Air Force and allied student pilots each year.

Chief Snarr entered the Air Force in June 1998 and graduated Aerospace Maintenance Apprentice Course in November 1998. During his career he has served in various positions within aircraft maintenance on multiple airframes. Additionally, he served as a C-130 Technical Training Instructor and a Flight Mechanic on several R/K/NC-135 variants, C-32B and C-235 accumulating more than 500 functional and flight test hours. He also served as Superintendent, 21st Expeditionary Reconnaissance Squadron, Crete, Greece where his unit was responsible for the execution of Sensitive Reconnaissance and Contingency Operations in AFRICOM, CENTCOM, and EUCOM, participating in operations EURO WATCH, JUNIPER SHIELD and INHERENT RESOLVE.



Prior to assuming his current position, he served as the Senior Enlisted Leader, Air Force Special Operations Command Inspector General, Hurlburt Field, Florida.
