COLONEL JESSE P. CALDWELL

Colonel Jesse P. Caldwell is the Deputy Commander, 47th Flying Training Wing, Air Education and Training Command, Laughlin Air Force Base, Texas. The wing consists of 2,800 personnel conducting undergraduate pilot training for more than 600 United States Air Force and allied student pilots each year. The wing operates 195 aircraft, consisting of the T-1A, T-6A and T-38C, and flies more than 66,000 hours and more than 44,000 sorties annually.

Colonel Caldwell received his commission in 2001 through the Reserve Officer Training Corps program at Clemson University, South Carolina. As a mobility pilot, he has flown the C-130E/H and KC-135R/T aircraft supporting numerous contingency operations in Southwest Asia. He was selected for Air Mobility Command's PHOENIX REACH program in 2008 and later served as an Air Officer Commanding at the U.S. Air Force Academy. He has flown over 3,300 flight hours performing combat airlift, airdrop, aeromedical evacuation, and air refueling missions. He commanded at the squadron level in garrison and combat. Prior to assuming his current position, Colonel Caldwell was the Director of Operations, 618 Air Operations Center (Tanker Airlift Control Center), Scott Air Force Base, Illinois.
