SMSgt Kerin N. Lange is the Development Advisor, 87th Force Support Squadron, Joint Base McGuire-Dix-Lakehurst, New Jersey. As the principal advisor to commanders and senior enlisted leaders on retention and force management at the Department of War's only tri-service joint base, she guides the career progression of 4,300 Airmen. Her responsibilities include providing essential counsel on reenlistment, retraining, and diverse career broadening opportunities. Additionally, she leads multi-tiered professional development courses designed to strategically develop the enlisted force and prepare Company Grade Officers for positions of increasing responsibility.

Senior Lange entered the Air Force in December 2008 and graduated from technical training as an Aerospace Medical Service Apprentice. Throughout her career, she has served in a variety of leadership roles within Air Mobility Command, U.S. Air Force in Europe, and Air Force Global Strike Command. Notably, her expertise was recognized when she was selected to serve as the lead medic for a joint recovery team on a mission to Vietnam with the Defense POW/MIA Accounting Agency.
