COLONEL ANDREW VELAZQUEZ KATZ

Col. Andrew Velazquez Katz is the Deputy Commander of the 47th Flying Training Wing, Laughlin Air Force Base, Texas. The wing consists of 2,800 personnel conducting specialized undergraduate pilot training for more than 500 United States Air Force and allied student pilots each year. The wing operates 195 aircraft, consisting of the T-1A, T-6A and T-38C, and flies more than 66,000 hours and more than 44,000 sorties per year.

Col. Katz was born in East Los Angeles, CA and received his commission in 2000. He is a command pilot with more than 3,500 hours in the T-1, T-37, F-16, U-2 and KC-10A aircraft, including 104 combat air refueling missions in Operation IRAQI and ENDURING FREEDOM. He has held several key flying, operational, and strategic positions including two tours at Air Education Training Command and one as a Formal Training Unit (FTU) Instructor Pilot in combat air refueling. Prior to his current assignment, Col. Katz served as the Vice Commandant, Global College of Professional Military Education (GCPME) at Maxwell AFB, AL. He has also held multiple positions ranging from Chief of the KC-10 Formal Training Unit (FTU) at Travis Air Force Base, CA, Wing Director of Staff (DS) for the 376th Air Expeditionary Wing at Manas, Kyrgyz Republic, Executive Assistant to the Chief of Staff (COS) for the NATO Allied Joint Force Command in Naples, Italy, Commander of the 47th Operations Support Squadron at Laughlin AFB, TX, and Deputy Group Commander for the 47th Operations Group at Laughlin AFB, TX. Most recently, Col. Katz graduated from Air War College (AWC) where he served as Class President and key member of the HAP Arnold Executive Leadership Series for the AWC Class of 2021.



Col. Katz commissioned in 2000 having attended Northwestern Prep School, the United States Air Force Academy Prep-School, the United States Air Force Academy, Loyola Marymount University, and California State University (Dominguez Hills).

Col Katz is married to Marlene Katz of East Los Angeles, CA. They have three children: Kaitlyn age 22, Andrew age 19, and Leilah age 16.
